



INSTITUTIONAL ORDINANCE

- 1. Parents/guardians are requested to go through college prospectus thoroughly and comply with the instruction given there in.
- 2. Seats are limited in hostel accommodation. The hostel accommodation will be allotted as per "first come –first serve" basis.
- 3. It's compulsory for every nursing student to wear college uniform from Monday to Friday. Students should come in simple dresses, wearing of unbecoming glamorous clothes and jewelry is strictly prohibited.
- 4. All technical and Pharmacy students have to wear apron during lab work.
- 5. Boys are not allowed to wear chains, lockets and earring etc.
- 6. Punctuality to the campus or classes is essential throughout the duration of course.
- 7. Good moral conduct is expected from every candidate. The expected behaviors of students are:-
 - Respecting the seniors and teachers
 - Fulfilling the assignments given with loyalty
 - Regularity to classes, clinical and other assigned duties
- 8. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited to use during class time & clinical duty.
- 9. Ragging in any form (teasing, abuse, physical torture, etc.) is strictly prohibited and punishable. The punishment is to the extent of two years rigorous imprisonment, fine of Rs. 10,000/-and dismissal from the institution.
- 10. An undertaking signed by each student, and his/her parent (s) jointly stating that each of them have read the relevant instructions/regulations against ragging, as well as punishments, and that if the ward has been found guilty he/she shall be proceeded against, shall be procured. Such an undertaking shall be furnished at the beginning of each academic year by every student.
- 11. Damage to any college property is extremely punishable.
- 12. Students are not allowed to wander in the campus or sit in the reception or office Without any reason.
- 13. A Student should apply for leave when it's absolutely necessary. He/She should secure it personally before it is availed of, except in case of illness, where leave application with a medical certificate must be submitted immediately on resuming studies.
- 14. Regular attendance to classes and clinical are mandatory. It's compulsory that individual candidate must have 80% attendance in theory block and 100% attendance in clinical block at the completion of each academic year to appear in annual exams.
- 15. The college timings are scheduled from 9 am to 3:30 pm.
- 16. Leaves availed on clinical blocks must be compensated with makeup duties in the same session itself, otherwise relieving from the institution will be delayed at the completion of course.
- 17. The sick candidate will not be sent to home alone; their guardians / parents must come to pick up them.

- 18. Periodic evaluation reports will be sent to the candidates home which demands feedback/ acknowledgement from their parents.
- 19. The individual candidate must cultivate the habit of reading notice board and newspaper to update the information.
- 20. If a student does not clear the condition laid down by the Institution he/she is liable to any sort of disciplinary action (Memo, Penalty, Dismiss, Suspension) or the candidate will be retained from annual exams else relieving certificate will be issued very late as per their deeds.
- 21. Prayer rooms are available for each religious group in Hostel. Students can utilize that for prayer gathering.
- 22. Hostel day/ night will be celebrated every year for student entertainment purpose. Students should read the notices/circulars and other notifications displayed on the Notice Board and abide as directed therein.
- 23. Change of address & phone / mobile numbers must be promptly intimated to the office.
- 24. Students should wear their ID card as long as they are in the campus. It should be produced on demand.
- 25. In case of accidents, we had its tie up with major hospital in the city and have the facility of Ambulance.

GENERAL FEES RULES:

- 1. Fee once paid shall not be refunded.
- 2. Examination fees must be paid at the given time otherwise individual candidate must pay penalty as per university norms
- 3. Any candidate who wants to discontinue from the institution has to pay the fee charges of complete course.
- 4. At the time of issuing the admit cards of annual university exams, the individual candidate must produce **No due slip** to the office. After clearance of all the dues only admit card will be issued.
- 5. For gross indiscipline student can be expelled from the institute without refunding the fees.
- 6. Penalties are applicable as per penalty norms of the institution.
- 7. Tuition fee, boarding and lodging fee are to be paid till 10th of every month
- 8. If a candidate fails to appear in examination with any reason the institute will not entertain any claim for refund of fees.
- 9. The fee mentioned is provisional. It can be varied as per the respective university fee instructions

FACILITIES & LABORATORIES

1. Pharmaceutics Lab

Pharmaceutics is the discipline of pharmacy that deals with the practical aspects of manufacturing, formulation and evaluation of various pharmaceutical dosage forms. A graduate shall be able to formulate, store, dispense, and analyze the prescription and/or manufacture the pharmaceuticals and cosmetics at the commercial level. The subject also helps the student to acquire knowledge and skill to apply quality assurance principles, including legal and ethical aspects involving drugs, delivering a quality assured product as per the pharmacopoeias, WHO and ISO standards. Practical aspects of product detailing and marketing of pharmaceutical products are also taught.



2. Pharmaceutical Chemistry Lab

Pharmaceutical Chemistry is applied chemistry which embraces organic, bioinorganic, physical, phytochemical and analytical chemistry. These disciplines are applied in the preparation, synthesis, Isolation and characterization, standardization, interpretation of drug interactions and analysis of chemical substances for medicinal use. The focus of the department is on the fundamental concepts and principles in organic, physical, medicinal and analytical chemistry to pharmaceuticals and then relate these concepts to drug synthesis, manufacturing and quality assurance in the practice of pharmacy.



Pharmaceutical Chemistry enables the student to synthesize, purify and identify the medicinal agents. This lab provides facilities for training basic and advanced concept of organic chemistry. The lab is well equipped with latest instruments to impart training to the students. They are familiarized with various organic compounds by their nature, physical and chemical properties and usage in chemical reactions and pharmaceutical industries

3. Pharmaceutical Analysis Lab

The Pharmaceutical analysis looks after the quality control and quality assurance aspects of medicines. This lab is equipped with glassware for pharmaceutical analysis like burette, pipette, volumetric flasks, measuring cylinder micro pipette etc. This Lab helps students to learn about qualitative and quantitative analysis of drugs in accordance with various pharmacopoeias method. The lab is specifically designed for the students to study various analytical methods like titration, conductometry, potentiometry, limit tests and the principles of volumetric and electro chemical analysis. The lab is equipped with modern equipment like conductometer, potentiometer, pH meter, and UV spectrophotometry to develop analytical skills of the students.



4. Pharmacognosy Lab

The subject of Pharmacognosy deals with drugs of natural sources like herbal drug cultivation methods, bio-technological methods, formulation and production of pharmaceutical herbal products and their evaluation. The students will develop adequate skill to extract, purify, identify, and know the therapeutic value of herbal/crude/natural products. The lab provides esteemed guidelines to the students regarding natural source of drugs and phytochemical screening through various instruments. The laboratory is utilized for morphological and anatomy study of drugs of natural origin. The lab is associated with a museum in which herbal drugs are displayed. A herbarium is also maintained in the lab for identification of the



A Botanical garden in the campus is available to catter the need of pharmacognosy lab. This is the place where the students study the aspects of natural drugs. The lab is equipped for identification, isolation of phytopharmaceuticals, macro, microscopic, physical & chemical characterization of natural drugs.

5. Anatomy & Physiology Lab

It is established to understand the Human Anatomy and Physiology of diseased state with the help of charts, models including human skeleton and various types of apparatus. During the course of study, the students understand the detailed anatomy and physiology of various organs of the human body. Experiments for blood count, hemoglobin measurement, blood group, blood pressure and tidal volume estimation are conducted. This course provides an introduction to the structure and function of the human body. It begins with an orientation to the



body and then covers the functions of a generalized cell – the atoms and molecules that make up organic molecules, tissues, organs, organ systems as well as the integumentary, skeletal, muscular and nervous systems. The focus is on the healthy functioning of the body and consideration of how each system contributes to overall health and the maintenance of homeostasis. This course covers the nervous system and the senses in addition to the endocrine, circulatory, respiratory, urinary, digestive and reproductive systems.

6. Pharmacology Lab

The laboratory provides to the student to basic methodologies used to evaluate how drugs modify physiological functions, through interactions with specific receptors at distinct sites. It gives an hands on experience to measure and calculate several important parameters.

This helps the student gain knowledge and scientific information regarding pharmacology of drugs, practical aspects of pharmacological screening for various medicinal agents using the animal model for pharmacology calculations, biological standardization, and in vivo drug interactions and toxicity studies. The lab has all the equipments to investigate various drug samples like convulsiometer, analgesiometer, histamine chamber etc.



7. Pharmacy Practice Lab

The subject of Pharmacy Practice deals with Hospital, Clinical and Community Pharmacy. It provides understanding of the processes involved in providing primary healthcare, drug information and other clinical pharmacy service in different practice environments. This enables students to acquire knowledge of clinical studies for patient counseling drug information, adverse drug reaction monitoring, toxicological studies, and therapeutic drug monitoring and other similar aspects of Clinical Pharmacy.



The lab also focuses for the analysis of biological samples like urine, blood, sugars, amino acids, cholesterol, fats. It is well equipped with modern equipment like centrifuge and UV spectrophotometer for conduct the experiments as per syllabus.









8. Machine Room

According to the guidelines of AICTE and PCI we have a well equipped machine room with various instruments like tablet punching machine, Capsule filling machine, Ampoule washing and filling machine, bottle filling sealing machine etc which help the students to learn easily.



9. Computer Lab

The college has a well equipped computer Laboratory with highly configured computer systems, with various printers, LCD and Broadband capacity. All are connected to the centralized LAN. The computer lab is provided to the students for project work, power point presentations and surfing to keep them updated to face the competitive world.



10. Library

The Library is an essential component of the institute's outstanding education and research mission. It is an area where students can place themselves comfortably with the books to seek and enhance information. The college has well-stocked library with a large number of books on subjects related to te course taught, in addition to literary volumes, ready reference encyclopedias etc. The college subscribes to all important newspapers, magazines, national and international books and journals.

HOSTEL NORMS

- 1. Hostel fees must be paid promptly, with in the given time.
- 2. Mess fees must be paid every month to the office.
- 3. Any student wishes to leave the hostel permanently must give prior notice of 3 months, only at the end of the academic year; they will be relieved from hostel. In case of any emergency, without permission, if the student wishes to leave the hostel, she has to pay for the 3 months hostel fee in advance.
- 4. Each student is accountable for the cleanliness of hostel.
- 5. Saving the water& electricity should be a reminder for all students.
- 6. Each student must follow the scheduled timing strictly else they have to pay the penalty.
- 7. The student will receive the night pass / night stay at home only ONCE IN A MONTH, LAST SATURDAY The students who are for away from Amritsar will be allowed to go Once in two months from Saturday to Thursday- The missed classes will be learned by themselves. (Self Study with the faculty guidance). The night pass will be restricted for the month prior to annual exams.
- 8. The students who wish to go home without parents/guardian must produce & submit the affidavit in the office.
- 9. The Students must get the signature from their respective class in charge two days prior to leave then from warden on the day of leaving.
- 10. In Case of any (genuine reason) leave in between the working days, students must apply the leave to class in charge with the evidence / phone call from their parents/ guardian can come and take the permission, ONLY FROM CLASS INCHARGE.
- 11. In case of any sick leave, the students will be relieved / given leave from hostel only for particular days based on their medical evidence, treatment slips, and diagnostic studies etc, WILL BE RECOMMENDED BY VICE PRINCIPAL.
- 12. Sick students will be allowed to keep medicines with, themselves only after getting permission from principal/ Vice principal. If any time they are found with medicine without permission will be penalized (the amount Rs. 100/-).
- 13. Previous Major illness must be reported to class In charge and Hostel Warden at the beginning of session itself, by the parents with medical evidence.
- 14. Visitors are allowed to meet the students only after working hour 4 p.m. 6 p.m. Saturday 1 pm 6 pm, last Saturday & Sunday 10am 5pm.
- 15. Visitors are strictly prohibited to visit their wards during official hours.
- 16. Visitors will be allowed to enter the hostel with the visitor card.
- 17. Outgoing / shopping will be allowed only once in a month.
